Eligibilty

- Student must have participated in the congregational life of the Fredericksburg United Methodist Church.
- Student must demonstrate outstanding academic achievement and participation in both church and community services.
- Student must be a candidate for High School graduation at the end of the current academic year. To be eligible for the Virginia Thompson Scholarship, the applicant must have been admitted to a four-year college for the following academic year. The Fredericksburg United Methodist Foundation Scholarship requires admission to either a two-year or four-year college for the following academic year. The Mary Alice Merchant Scholarship is for a graduating senior from a local high school who will be attending college, community college or technical school in the fall."

Application Process

• Interested applicants should contact the FUMC Youth Director or the Senior Pastor to obtain for an application. The application and the required additional information must be submitted to the FUMC Youth Director, David Carryer, **no later than Easter Sunday, April 17, 2022.**

Requirements for Submitting Application

- High School Transcript with SAT and/or ACT Scores. Transcript of grades received during the senior year. (report card).
- A total of three letters of recommendation: one from guidance counselor, principal, or teacher; one from a person of the student's choice (employer, friend); and one from a person who has worked with the applicant in church.
- Applicant will provide an essay on "How do you see your church experiences impacting on your professional goals for life".
- Listing of school, church, and community activities.
- A copy of the acceptance letter from the college that he/she plans to attend with the address of the college where the scholarship check will be sent.
